NUW TOP 30 POTCHEFSTROOM

King Edward VII School were able to tour to Potchefstroom on Thursday 14 October to compete in the NWU Top 30 meeting on Friday 15 October and Saturday 16 October 2021. The format of the meeting is that schools can enter 23 athletes in various pre-determined events. No more than 6 athletes per age group and there is compulsory throwing, jumping, and running events. No athlete may compete in more than 2 events.

There were approximately 80 schools that enter, and individuals could enter as well. Schools also entered more than one team.

In any given event there were anywhere from 10 – 40 competitors in various heats and finals.
